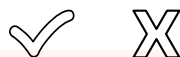

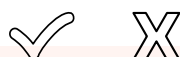

TASK 1



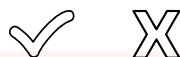

TASK 2



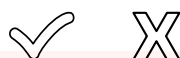

TASK 4



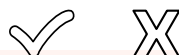

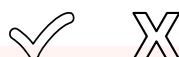

TASK 6



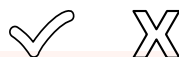
