

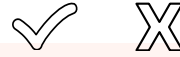

## TASK 1



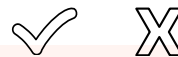
Students are introduced to constitutional reform as a dominant idea of the SNP. Students watch the Channel 4 News video, read the notes and then answer four questions. **CAS Link: *The dominant ideas within or between political parties.***

## TASK 2



Students are introduced to a second dominant idea of the SNP: social justice and fairness. The students watch a short film from the Scottish Government about the Baby Box, read the notes and then answer five questions. **CAS Link: *The dominant ideas within or between political parties.***

## TASK 3



Students watch the short film on 'Scoxit' to help them understand the context of the pro-European dominant idea of the SNP. They can read the notes and answer the 5 questions. **CAS Link: *The dominant ideas within or between political parties.***

## TASK 4



Students explore the fourth dominant idea of the SNP: Law and Order. There is a video of Karyn McCluskey talking about the VRU to watch. Students should then read the notes and answer the four questions. **CAS Link: *The dominant ideas within or between political parties.***

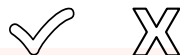
