

TASK 2



Students are introduced to a second dominant idea of the SNP: social justice and fairness. The students watch a short film from the Scottish Government about the Baby Box, read the notes and then answer five questions. *CAS Link: The dominant ideas within or between political parties.*

TASK 3



Students watch the short film on 'Scoxit' to help them understand the context of the pro-European dominant idea of the SNP. They can read the notes and answer the 5 questions. *CAS Link: The dominant ideas within or between political parties.*

TASK 4


